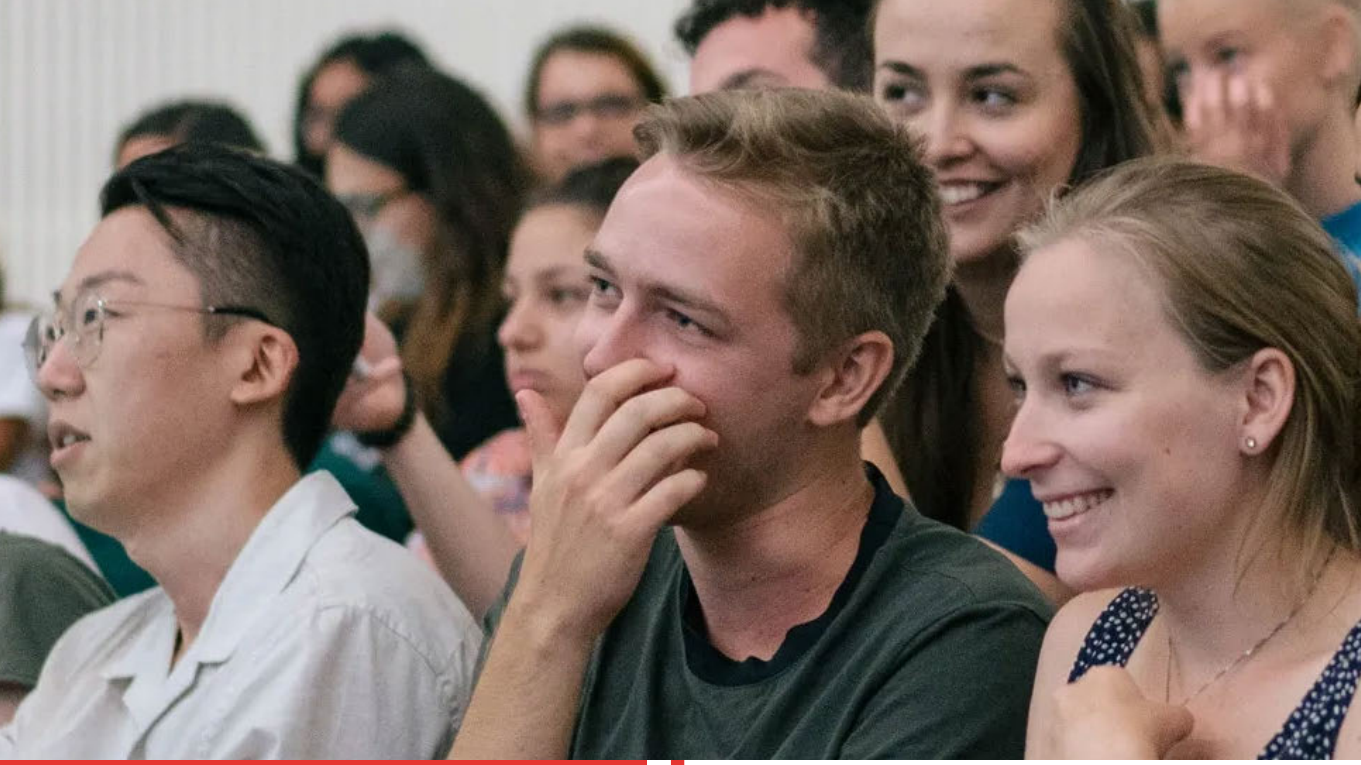
Research

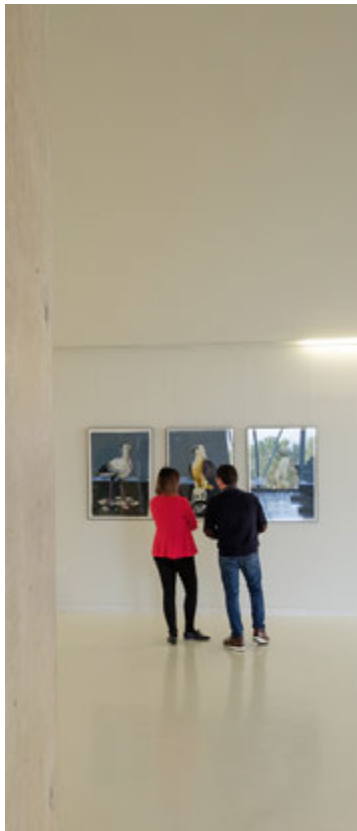
Our **Library**, is a vibrant contemporary space with outstanding learning facilities.
