## European Credit transfer system

San Jorge University uses a local grading scale with marks between 0 and 10.

10 reflects the maximum score; 5 is the minimum mark to pass an exam and obtain credits: less than 5 means a failure.

The main language of teaching is Spanish, therefore we strongly advice students to sign up for the intensive Spanish language course for exchange students upon their arrival.

The recommended language level is B1 both for English and/or Spanish. Students of Nursing and Physiotherapy taking clinical practice require a B2 level of Spanish.
