FORMAT: two candidates and two examiners.

TOTAL DURATION: 16 to 18 minutes.

PART 1 – Informal interview personal questions - 4 minutes

Examples :

Leisure time

- What do you like doing in your free time?
- Have your free time activities changed in the last few years?
- Is there any new free time activity you would like to do?

Time

- Are you good at managing your time?
- Do you use a diary or a calendar or an agenda?
- Do you think you waste much time?

Social networks

- Do you use social networks much?
- What kind of things do you put on your social network sites?
- Do you think that using social networks has changed your life in any way?

PART 2 – Describe and compare 2 photos and comment – 4 minutes (2 minutes per candidate)

Example:

001 - Candidate A card part 2 – Games and Playing

Describe and compare the photos.

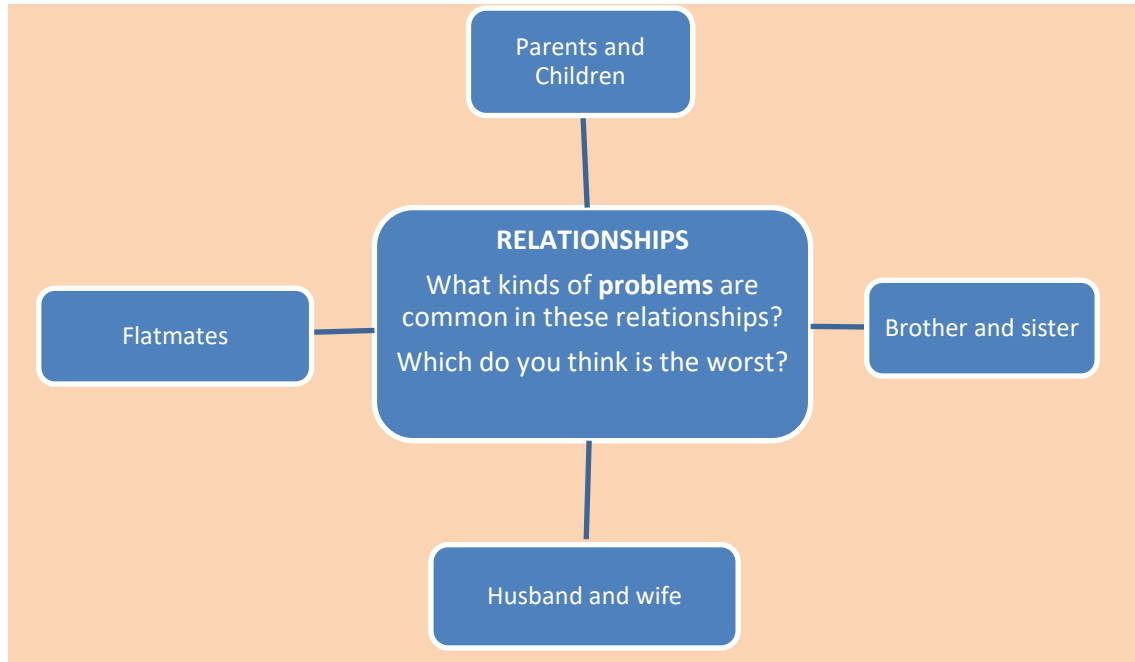
Say which of these games you prefer to play and why.



Question for Candidate B: Do you think the same?

PART 3 – Collaborative task - 4-5 minutes

Talk about and try to reach an agreement on the questions in the centre of the diagram. Before you begin you both have 1 minute to think about what you are going to say.

**PART 4 – Conversation related to task 3 – 4-5 minutes.**

Examiner asks some or all of the questions to both candidates.

- Have you experienced many of these problems?
- How did you try to resolve the problem(s)?
- Can you think of any other ways people could deal with these problems?
- How do you think money could cause problems in these relationships?
- And how can work affect some of these relationships?
- Do you think parents and children have different problems to those they had 50 years ago?
- And what about husbands and wives or boyfriend/girlfriend?
- In what ways do you think this type of problem may change in the future?
