Description

Spanish as a foreign language and Spanish culture courses designed for international students and professionals combining language classes with general Spanish content and a cultural experience in Zaragoza (Spain) and its surrounding areas.

Who is this program for

Students interested in learning and improving their level of Spanish. Students who are 16

to 18 years old must provide authorization from their parents or legal guardians.

July 6-17, 2026.
July 20-31, 2026.

Format

In-person.

Levels

A1, A2, B1, B2 and C1, per the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages

(CEFR).

Class Schedule

Full course: 40 hours
20 hours per week (2 weeks)
9:00 AM to 1:30 PM - Spanish language and culture classes
6:00 PM to 8:00 PM - Spanish culture and optional supplementary activities.

Location

USJ Campus (Villanueva de Gállego, Zaragoza, Spain).

Number of students

Small groups (maximum 20 students).

Course fees

2 weeks (Course only, without accommodation)
295 euros.

2 weeks (Course with accommodation and full board)
500 euros.

Access to USJ facilities and sports campus, free Wi-Fi, course materials, and a certificate of completion.
Extra day of accommodation (university residence hall):

Placement test

To register for a course level higher than A1, students will need to prove their Spanish level by submitting an official certificate or take a free online placement test prior to registration. On the first day of the course, students will take an in-person placement test to confirm their level and ensure optimal learning outcomes.

Certificate

Upon completion of the course, students will receive a certificate, provided they attend at least 80% of the classes and pass the corresponding assessment, in accordance with the criteria established by the Institute of Modern Languages as an Instituto Cervantes Accredited Centre.

Note: The level indicated in the certificate is for guidance purposes only. It does not constitute an official language certification. Language proficiency is only certified via official exams such as DELE or SIELE.

Accommodation
